Application Requirements

Self-Evaluation Form

The applicant must complete the self-evaluation form included with the WALC application.

Recommendation Forms

The applicant is responsible for having one recommendation form completed by the head coach of each sport in which they participate. The applicant must deliver the form to the coach. The coach is then responsible for returning the form to the WALC Leadership Staff.

Recommendation forms are attached.

Recommendation Letters

The applicant must attach a total of two letters of recommendation as outlined below. The letters should state examples of how you exhibit leadership, dedication, work ethic, and responsibility.

1. Parent or Guardian
2. Community Representative (No school representatives or relatives)

Essay

The applicant must complete a one page, 12 pt. font, double spaced essay based on the topic listed below.

Wayne Athletic Leadership Council Membership Requirements

- I. Any student-athlete currently in grades 9-12 interested in becoming a WALC member must meet the criteria listed below.
 - a. The student must complete the application process, including the general application section, self-evaluation recommendation forms from members of the Wayne Coaching Staff, recommendation letter from a parent/guardian, recommendation letter from a community member, and written essay.
 - b. The student-athlete applicant must attend the annual WALC Kick Off Meeting.
 - i. If unable to attend, the member would be placed on probation for a six week time period and must complete additional requirements to be removed from probation.
- II. WALC members are expected to abide by the WALC Membership Criteria in order to maintain their membership in good standing.
- III. Failure to comply with the WALC Membership Criteria can jeopardize your membership in WALC. A student-athlete whom fails to maintain membership in good standing may be removed from WALC. Removal from WALC is ultimately determined by the WALC Leadership Staff.
